Brazilian National Data Protection Authority (ANPD) opens registration to collect subsidies on the Data Protection Officer rule

The Labor Public Ministry includes the activity of the Data Protection Officer in the Brazilian Classification of Occupations (“CBO”)

Among the job description of the Data Protection Officer are the following activities:

- ✓ Planning of administrative, financial, compliance, risk, and personal data protection and privacy processes.
- ✓ Participation in the implementation of the compliance and/or privacy governance program.
- ✓ Monitoring and evaluation of compliance with the program policies, regulations, code of ethics, internal procedures, and business partners.
- ✓ Provide service to the customer and/or employee and/or data subject.
